He performed as an actor and singer in musicals (often in Brno City Theatre) and gave guest performances as a violoncellist in chamber and symphony orchestras (National Theatre Brno, Czech Virtuosi, Musica Bohemica, Brno City Theatre). He gave performances all over the Czech Republic as well as abroad (Germany, Slovakia, France, Austria, Croatia, Slovenia). He also participated in recording of various radio programs and CDs of many genres.

As a vocal coach he teaches movement, breathing and working with the human body together. He works with interpretation of different music genres well (pop, rock, jazz, musical, classical music) Given his broad range of skills, Pavel is able to share his experience not only as a singer or an actor, but also as a musician in the orchestra.
